5 Year Academic Strategic Goals

Horizon Goal: All students in grades K-12 will demonstrate proficiency on grade level standards.

Breathitt County School District will:

1. Reduce the overall percentage of students scoring at the novice level in reading and math by 50% by May 2025.
2. Increase the percentage of students reading on grade level when exiting primary to 80% by May 2025.
3. Increase the combined 4-year and 5-year cohort graduation rate from 90.8% to 95.55% by May 2025.
4. Increase the Transition Readiness rate from 68.8% to 88.4% by May 2025.
5. Increase the combined reading and math Proficiency Indicator by May 2025:
 - a. Elementary from 65.9 to 90.0
 - b. Middle from 64.0 to 88.0
 - c. High School from 48.0 to 78.0
6. Increase the percentage of economically disadvantaged students scoring proficient/distinguished in reading and math by May 2025. Additionally, no significant achievement gaps will be found in our schools or district.

8. Increase the attendance rate from 93.7% to 97% by May 2025.
